·A Personal Health Budget is provided by the Clinical Commissioning Group, who choose and pay for the health services your child needs in your area. A Personal Health Budget is for children and young people who have complex health care needs

Education

· A Personal Education Budget is where some / all of the provision in the EHCP is delivered via payments made to the parent / carer, young person over 16 years old, or a third party, **if the school allocated by the LA cannot meet or partially meet needs.**

·**Personal Budgets can only be used for provision to achieve outcomes set out in the CYP's EHCP.**

·Personal Budgets must only be agreed for 12 months, and must be reviewed at each Annual Review, with a 3 months and 6 months review.

·Personal Budgets are optional.
