

Analysis of pupil premium impacts in English: 2015



Year 10

All students- Average points increase of 1.1

Non PP students- made an average 1.0, slightly below expected, with 5 students showing no progress

PP students- made average 1.1, expected, with three students showing no progress

Positive impact shown, through reducing the gap. The three showing no progress- one had poor attendance; one had a close family bereavement; one was on a reduced timetable and has since left us.

Year 9

All students- Average points increase of 1.5

Non PP students- Average points increase of 2.3, well above expected

PP students- Average points increase of 2.5, a full level above expected progress.

Positive impact shown, pupil premium pupils have increased more.

Year 8

All students- Average points increase of 1.0

Non PP students- Average points increase of 0.9, below expected value of 1.6

PP students – Average points increase of 1.2, below expected value of 1.6 but above Non PP Students.

Positive impact shown, through reducing the gap. Below expected value but year 9 (2015) have been included in the literacy cohort for distar.

Year 7

All students- Average points increase of 2.1

Non PP students- Average points increase of 2.0, below expected.

PP students – Average points increase of 2.1, expected.

Positive impact shown, through reducing the gap.
